Lined Rolled-Brim Hat

Materials:

- MC: 1 skein of bulky weight yarn (appx. 100 yards), something warm and tough.
- CC: 1 skein DK weight yarn (appx. 120 yards), something soft.
- Circular needle, 8 US, 16"
- Double-pointed needles, 8 US
- 1 stitch marker
- Tapestry needle

Gauge:

- In bulky yarn, 16 ½ stitches and 25 rows to 4"
- In DK yarn, 21 stitches and 26 rows to 4".



Sizes: Small (20" head circumference) , Medium (22" circumference), Large (24" circumference)

Directions:

Cast on 77 (84, 91) stitches in MC on circular needle. Place Stitch Marker and join in the round, being careful not to twist.

Knit all stitches in the round until hat measures 6" (6 ½", 7") from cast on edge when laid flat. When relaxed, brim should roll up about 1".

Decrease for the top of the hat (switch to DPNs when circular needle is too long for the amount of stitches):

Round 1: Starting at the beginning of the round, *K9 (10, 11), K2tog* until end of round.

Round 2 and all even rounds: Knit.

Round 3: *K one fewer than in the previous repeat, K2tog* until end of round.

Repeat rounds 2 and 3 until 42 stitches remain.

Repeat round 3 only until 7 stitches remain (the last round will be worked K2tog around).

Cut yarn. Thread the end onto a tapestry needle and thread it through the remaining stitches; pull tight.

Flip the finished outer hat upside down and look at the brim. Just below the cast-on edge of the right side, you will see the first row of Vs. Using CC and the circular needle, pick up and knit into the right leg of each V (77 stitches). Join the round. Place a stitch marker at the beginning of the round.

Knit around until the CC liner hat measures 7" (7 ½", 8") from picked up stitches.

Repeat decreasing for the top described above. (Be sure to weave in all ends before you do so!)

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
